Arrival

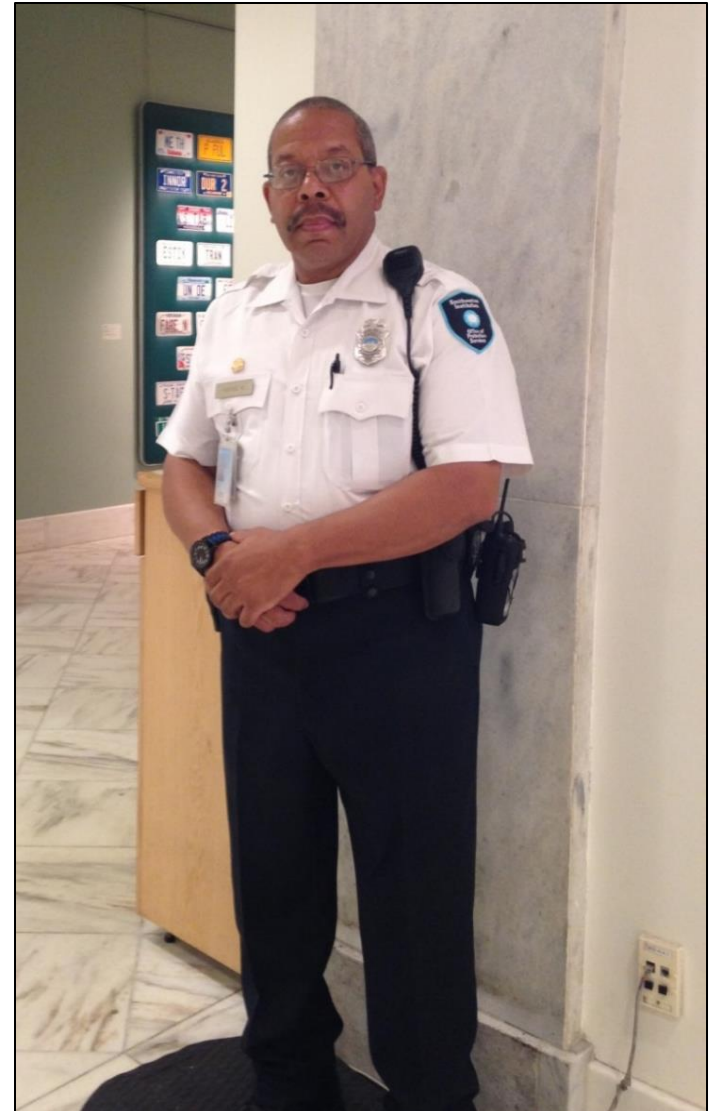
To enter the Renwick, visitors will walk up stairs to get to the front door.

There are also water fountains outside of the bathrooms.

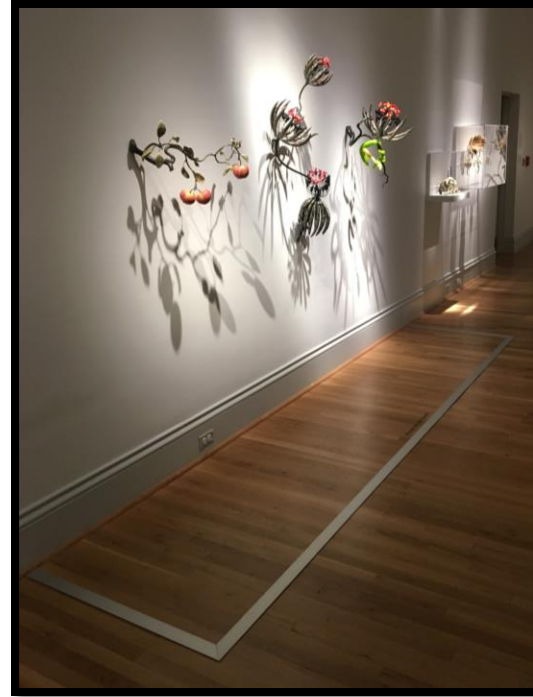


Keeping Art Safe

There are silver boxes on the ground around art to show visitors where they should be.

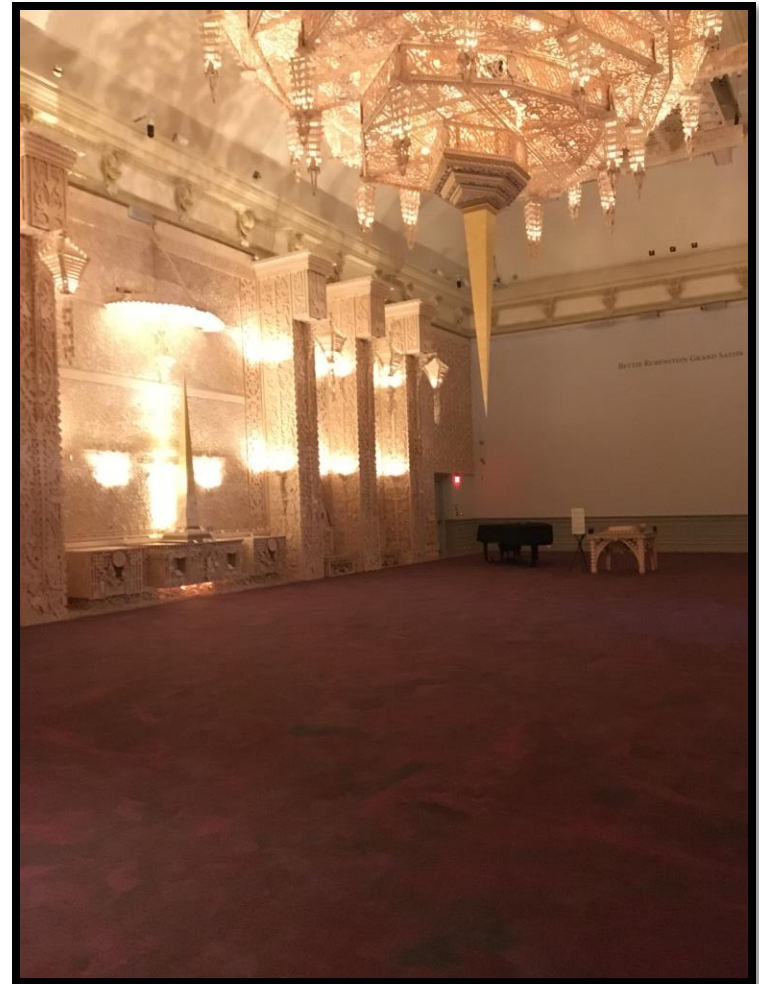
There are also signs to remind visitors not to touch.
